

GINGA NORTH ATLANTIC CLUB: Financial Aid Procedures

Ginga North Atlantic is committed to providing futsal opportunities to the region's top soccer and futsal players, regardless of financial capacities. However, the Club's resources are not unlimited, and it must make judicious use of its aid. The procedures below will help us to decide how to best help you and your family.

Steps to apply for Financial Aid

- 1. In a written statement, please tell us the following:
 - a. What are the main reasons that your family requires financial aid?
 - b. How much you can afford to pay for the program?
 - c. Are you able to volunteer for the Club? What activities are you able to do? Possibilities include:
 - Video record games at league and tournaments
 - Coordinate travel arrangements, as needed
 - Coordinate administrative tasks for one or more teams (gather birth certificates, insurance payment certificates, other)
- 2. Once you have submitted the answers to the above questions, your application will be reviewed by the Futsal Director and the Chief Financial Officer.

You will be notified of the Club's decision within two weeks of your application.
